

The AARP Smart Driver Course, offered by AARP Driver Safety, is the nation's first and largest refresher course designed specifically for drivers age 50 and older. For more than 30 years, the course has taught millions of drivers proven safety strategies so they can continue driving safely for as long as possible.

The new, updated course is scheduled for Thursday, June 2 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Taylor Community's Woodside Building, 435 Union Ave. Class size is limited to 20 people.

To sign up, please call 524-5600, Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. The nominal fee is \$15 for AARP members and \$20 for non-members, payable the day of class. AARP members should bring their cards. There will be a break for lunch and the Woodside Café is available for dining.

This course will help participants:

- Learn research-based safety strategies that can reduce the likelihood of having a crash
- Understand the link among the driver, vehicle, and road environment, and how this awareness encourages safer behavior
- Learn how aging, medications, alcohol and other health-related issues affect driving ability and ways to adjust how to allow for these changes
- Increase confidence
- Know how to drive safely when sharing the road with other road users
- Learn the newest safety and advanced features in vehicles
- Learn when driving may no longer be safe
- Explore other ways to travel

Youth Mental Health First Aid

An 8-hour certification course for caring adults who want to help youth (ages 12-18) who may be in crisis or experiencing a mental health challenge.



The course is designed for adults who regularly interact with adolescents (teachers, school staff, coaches, youth group leaders, parents, bus drivers, etc.). In January 2013, President Obama recommended Youth Mental Health Training for all. The core Mental Health First Aid course has been successfully offered to more than 100,000 people across the USA, including hospital staff, employers and business leaders, faith communities, law enforcement, and the general public.

WHO: *Anyone who works with adolescents*

WHAT: *Youth Mental Health First Aid*

WHEN: *8 sessions available - 8:00 - 4:00 pm - You need only sign up for one training session

COST: *Free (Cost supported by the Project AWARE Grant)*

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS LEARN?

The course teaches participants the risk factors and warning signs of a variety of mental health challenges common among adolescents, including anxiety, depression, psychosis, eating disorders, AD/HD, disruptive behavior disorders, and substance use disorder. Participants do not learn to diagnose, nor how to provide any therapy or counseling – rather, participants learn to support a youth developing signs and symptoms of a mental illness or in an emotional crisis by applying a core five-step action plan:

~Assess for risk of suicide or harm

~Listen nonjudgmentally

~Give reassurance and information

~Encourage appropriate professional help

~Encourage self-help and other support strategies

The Youth Mental Health First Aid USA curriculum is primarily focused on information participants can use to help adolescents and transition-age youth, ages 12-18.



Attention parents of Laconia school-age children, we are accepting registration forms for **GOT LUNCH! Laconia**, a summer healthy lunch program that delivers enough groceries including fresh fruit and vegetables, to provide five lunches a week to each registered child's home. All Laconia school age children are eligible. Although our target population are those families who qualify for 'free and reduced' lunches at the school, it is NOT a requirement for participation. If you need the help this summer, this program is designed for you. Any family is eligible to register their child(ren). GOT LUNCH! Laconia does not want any child to go hungry this summer.

A week's worth of healthy lunch groceries will be delivered to your home, mid to late morning every Monday during the school summer vacation. We also provide Dairy Vouchers redeemable at Vista Foods for your choice of milk, eggs, cheese or yogurt. Once you are registered you will receive a letter describing the details of the dairy voucher program.




