Resident Beach Stickers Available June 20th!



The summer season will soon be upon us and it's almost time to hit the beach! If you would like to go to Bond Beach or park in the Weirs Beach parking lot during the summer you will need a resident beach sticker. Stickers are available beginning June 20 at the City Clerk and Tax Collector Offices. Stickers are assigned to a vehicle and you will need to provide your vehicle registration. There is a maximum of two stickers per household, and a fee of \$15.00 will apply (\$25.00 for two stickers if they are purchased **at the same time**).



Youth Mental Health First Aid

An 8-hour certification course for caring adults who want to help youth (ages 12-18) who may be in crisis or experiencing a mental health challenge.



The course is designed for adults who regularly interact with adolescents (teachers, school staff, coaches, youth group leaders, parents, bus drivers, etc.). In January 2013, President Obama recommended Youth Mental Health Training for all. The core Mental Health First Aid course has been successfully offered to more than 100,000 people across the USA, including hospital staff, employers and business leaders, faith communities, law enforcement, and the general public.

WHAT: *Youth Mental Health First Aid*

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS LEARN?

The course teaches participants the risk factors and warning signs of a variety of mental health challenges common among adolescents, including anxiety, depression, psychosis, eating disorders, AD/HD, disruptive behavior disorders, and substance use disorder. Participants do not learn to diagnose, nor how to provide any therapy or counseling – rather, participants learn to support a youth developing signs and symptoms of a mental illness or in an emotional crisis by applying a core five-step action plan:

~Assess for risk of suicide or harm

~Listen nonjudgmentally

~Give reassurance and information

~Encourage appropriate professional help

~Encourage self-help and other support strategies

The Youth Mental Health First Aid USA curriculum is primarily focused on information participants can use to help adolescents and transition-age youth, ages 12-18.



Got Lunch! Laconia is seeking volunteers interested in delivering lunch groceries once per week for the 10-week summer program. GOT LUNCH! Laconia is a summer healthy lunch program that delivers directly to family homes each week enough groceries to provide five lunches a week for each registered child. We expect an increase in the number of children registered this year and expect to serve over 650 children. GOT LUNCH! Laconia does not want any child to go hungry this summer.

A one hour training session is scheduled for June 10 at 5 PM, in the basement of the Congregational Church of Laconia, 18 Veteran's Square. Training will consist of a safety presentation by Laconia Police Department and the procedure for delivering. Deliveries are done in pairs so bring a friend or GOT LUNCH! Laconia will give you a partner.

Deliveries begin on Monday, June 20th and will end on Monday, August 22. Due to the Monday July 4th holiday delivery will be on Tuesday, July 5th that week. If time is an issue you can sign up to commit to half of the summer (5 weeks). Deliveries are Monday mornings from 9 – 11am. During training, volunteers will be asked to produce a valid driver's license, proof of insurance, and fill out the program's liability insurance form.


