




Resident Beach Stickers Are Now Available!



Summer is finally here and it's time to head to the beach! If you would like to go to Bond Beach or park in the Weirs Beach parking lot during the summer you will need a resident beach sticker. Stickers are available at the City Clerk and Tax Collector Offices. Stickers are assigned to a vehicle and you will need to provide your vehicle registration.

There is a maximum of two stickers per household, and a fee of \$15.00 will apply (\$25.00 for two stickers if they are purchased **at the same time**).

Youth Mental Health First Aid

An 8-hour certification course for caring adults who want to help youth (ages 12-18) who may be in crisis or experiencing a mental health challenge.



The course is designed for adults who regularly interact with adolescents (teachers, school staff, coaches, youth group leaders, parents, bus drivers, etc.). In January 2013, President Obama recommended Youth Mental Health Training for all. The core Mental Health First Aid course has been successfully offered to more than 100,000 people across the USA, including hospital staff, employers and business leaders, faith communities, law enforcement, and the general public.

WHO: *Anyone who works with adolescents*

WHAT: *Youth Mental Health First Aid*

WHEN: *8 sessions available - 8:00 - 4:00 pm - You need only sign up for one training session

August 8, 9, 10, 11*

WHERE: *SAU #30 Administrative Office, Conference Room, 39 Harvard Street, Laconia, NH*

COST: *Free (Cost supported by the Project AWARE Grant)*

WHAT WILL PARTICIPANTS LEARN?

The course teaches participants the risk factors and warning signs of a variety of mental health challenges common among adolescents, including anxiety, depression, psychosis, eating disorders, AD/HD, disruptive behavior disorders, and substance use disorder. Participants do not learn to diagnose, nor how to provide any therapy or counseling – rather, participants learn to support a youth developing signs and symptoms of a mental illness or in an emotional crisis by applying a core five-step action plan:

~Assess for risk of suicide or harm

~Listen nonjudgmentally

~Give reassurance and information

~Encourage appropriate professional help

~Encourage self-help and other support strategies

The Youth Mental Health First Aid USA curriculum is primarily focused on information participants can use to help adolescents and transition-age youth, ages 12-18.

PETER S. KARAGIANIS DAY

in the City of Laconia and bestow this honor in memory of Peter to recognize his love of the City and his commitment to making it the best it could be.

Peter Karagianis was born in Somerville, Massachusetts and June 25, 2016 will mark the 100th anniversary of that occasion. Although Peter was not born in New Hampshire, we are fortunate that he chose to move to Laconia in 1945 and make it his home. Since that time he devoted himself tirelessly to improving the community in countless ways, earning him the honorary title of "Mr. Laconia".

Among Peter's many achievements and contributions to numerous organizations was perhaps his most cherished effort to save Laconia's Belknap Mill from demolition. We are standing today in front of the result of his hard work and commitment; the Mill stands as a testament to our past and a legacy for our future.

We are here today to show our appreciation in memory of Peter Karagianis by naming the walkway between the historic Belknap and Busiel Mill buildings as "Peter Karagianis Way" as a reminder of what it means to be a leader within the community and how to set an example of civic engagement for others to follow. That was "his way" and how he lived his life.

NOW, THEREFORE, I call upon all of the citizens of Laconia to join with me in this ribbon cutting ceremony officially opening "Peter Karagianis Way" and remembering Peter S. Karagianis for his decades of service and dedication to our community.


