



## Warning Signs



As a parent, you may suspect that your child is abusing alcohol or other drugs. Maybe you've smelled alcohol on their breath; maybe they're sleeping all the time. You may sense a subtle change in behavior, appearance or mood.

Adolescence is an incredibly turbulent time. Kids often feel overwhelmed with grades or performance; they struggle with relationships, with friends, with romances, and with their parents or guardians. And some begin to use substances.

**If you think your child may be using, these warning signs of substance abuse may help you confirm your suspicions:**

- Sudden change in friends
- Decline in grades and schoolwork, with increased absences
- Secrecy about activities and cryptic conversations with friends, using "coded" language
- Changes in sleep patterns such as being up all night and sleeping a lot during the day
- Use of incense, odor neutralizer, or perfume to hide the smell of smoke
- New clothes that highlight or promote drug use
- Looks terrible, no longer cares about appearance and hygiene
- Borrows money; money disappears from sibling's or parent's handbags and wallets
- Evidence of pipes, rolling papers, etc.
- Empty cans of hairspray, glue bottles, correction fluid, with bags or rag products in trash or hidden
- Eye drops to eliminate bloodshot eyes
- New use of mouthwash or breath mints to cover up the smell of alcohol
- Missing prescription drugs, especially painkillers and tranquilizers or sedatives


# News From the Laconia Water Department

## Water Main Replacement



The Laconia Water Department will be replacing approximately 200 feet of 8-inch water main from the intersection of Water Street across Beacon Street West towards Pleasant Street, along with the repair/replacement of a leaky gate valve on Pleasant Street as part of our ongoing system improvement plan.

The map below shows the general area of excavation. Throughout our construction process Beacon Street West will remain open, but at times will be reduced to one-lane traffic. Furthermore, there will be one or two days in which Water Street will be closed at the Beacon Street West end. Traffic patterns, etc. have been discussed with the Public Works Department and emergency service providers, i.e. police and fire, will be made aware of each day's activities.

On Saturday, September 7, 2013 at Weirs Beach's Endicott Rock Park in Laconia, LakeFest attendees will attempt to capture a Guinness World Record for NH. *LakeFest: Hands Across the Water* is a family-friendly educational and entertainment event highlighted by a Guinness World Record attempt for the largest free floating raft of canoes and kayaks. The NH Lakes Association aims to get over 2,099 canoes and kayaks into the waters of Lake Winnepesaukee to break the current record. Thanks to the help of countless volunteers and Belknap Landscape Company (providing a generator, crane and other equipment for the event), this promises to be a fun and exciting day!

Registration opens at 7 am on Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup>, and the Guinness World Record raft attempt begins at approximately 10 am. LakeFest attendees will launch from three official sites: Meredith Bay, Akwa Marina, and Endicott Rock Park (the LakeFest event site at Weirs Beach). The free on-land Festival opens mid-morning on Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup> and runs through 4 pm at Weirs Beach's Endicott Rock Park. On land, attendees will hear a lineup of great live music: The O'Brien Clan Band and The Floods will delight listeners. Family-friendly activities include storytelling, LakeFest bingo, a bounce house, kayak limbo, and more. There will be food vendors and educational exhibits, in addition to boats and other watersport gear for sale. Raffle tickets for a brand new 12' Dirigo Old Town kayak with paddle and PFD will be available for purchase. We hope to see you there!

## MDMA Fact Sheet

Known as "Ecstasy," "Molly", "XTC", "E"

**What is it?** Ecstasy's scientific name is MDMA (methylenedioxy-methamphetamine). Street names include "ecstasy", "molly", "XTC", "E". It is a synthetic, mind-altering drug that acts both as a stimulant and a hallucinogenic. However, research shows that Ecstasy tablets can contain a number of other drugs that can be dangerous when combined, including methamphetamine, ketamine, cocaine, caffeine, DXM and the diet drug ephedrine.

**How is it taken?** It is a drug sold either as a pressed pill taken orally, or as a powder that is snorted or swallowed. A typical dose of 100 to 125 mg lasts approximately four to six hours.

**Risks:** Like any other stimulant, MDMA will increase your heart rate and blood pressure. Other physical effects include tremors, muscle cramps, nausea, faintness, chills, sweating and blurred vision. People who use MDMA are also at risk of dehydration, which may not seem like a big deal, but by interfering with the body's ability to regulate its temperature, it puts you at risk of dangerous, sometimes fatal, overheating.

Shortly after taking MDMA, you may also feel confusion, depression and severe anxiety—but these psychological effects have also been reported to occur days or weeks after taking the drug.

**Long-Term Effects:** MDMA directly affects the brain chemical serotonin, and how your brain cells communicate with each other. Clinical studies show that MDMA can be harmful to your brain and can increase the risk of long-term problems with memory and learning. Also, taking too much MDMA can interfere with the body's ability to regulate its temperature. This can cause hyperthermia and can lead to liver, kidney and cardiovascular failure.

### THE BOTTOM LINE

- **Because MDMA is illegal – and, therefore, unregulated – it is impossible to know what a "dose" contains.** In fact, many drugs sold as "ecstasy" or "molly" are not even MDMA. In addition, besides MDMA, "ecstasy" pills may contain varying levels of MDA (methylene-dioxyamphetamine), other stimulants such as cocaine, caffeine, or anesthetics such as Ketamine or dextromethorphan (DXM) and the diet drug ephedrine – which can significantly amplify potential harms.
