

Proper Use of a Fire Extinguisher

A portable fire extinguisher can save lives and property by putting out a small fire or containing it until the fire department arrives; but portable extinguishers have limitations. Because fire grows and spreads so rapidly, the extinguisher should only be used: when the fire is confined to a small area (such as a wastebasket) and is not growing; everyone has exited the building; the fire department has been called or is being called; and the room is not filled with smoke.



Remember!

Pull

Aim

Squeeze

Sweep



To operate a fire extinguisher, remember the word **PASS**:

- PULL** the pin. Hold the extinguisher with the nozzle pointing away from you, and release the locking mechanism.
- AIM** low. Point the extinguisher at the base of the fire.
- SQUEEZE** the lever slowly and evenly.
- SWEEP** the nozzle from side-to-side.





Need Help Budgeting? Debt Triage to the Rescue!

Are you in debt crisis? Haunted by the possibility of home foreclosure or eviction? No money at the end of the month for the "rest" of the bills? Do you need to cut, trim, or rework your budget? Don't have a budget?

On Thursday, September 26, from 6 to 8:30 p.m. a Debt Triage Workshop will be offered by the Laconia Area Community Land Trust (LACLCT). The workshop takes place at Taylor Community, 435 Union Avenue, Laconia – Woodside Building, Birch Room. Light refreshments will be available. The Debt Triage Workshop is free and generously sponsored by Franklin Savings Bank.

The class will cover budgeting, cutting waste, changing behaviors, prioritizing debt, credit repair, improving and understanding credit reporting, and more.
