





North Main Street Traffic Control Plan



SANITARY SEWER CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The City of Laconia Department of Public Works has hired a local contractor, John H. Lyman and Sons, Inc. to replace a section of the sanitary sewer main in North Main Street from the Central Fire Station to Opechee Cove Beach.

The work will cause traffic restrictions daily including two-way alternating traffic in one open lane and temporary road closures. Traffic delays will occur especially during commuting hours. The Department of Public Works asks commuters to seek alternate routes.

The duration of the project is approximately three weeks. The tentative start date is October 17, 2016.

Alternate routes include the following streets:

- Church Street, Union Ave., and Elm Street
- Church Street and Pleasant Street
- Various local side streets
