On Saturday, October 26, 2013, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) is coordinating a nationwide one-day collaborative effort with state and local law enforcement agencies to remove potentially dangerous controlled substances from our nation's homes. This national initiative will again provide an opportunity for the public to surrender pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications to law enforcement officers for destruction. Expired, unused, or unwanted controlled substances in our homes are a potential source of supply for the increasing abuse of pharmaceutical drugs in the United States and an unacceptable risk to public health and safety.

## WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT LACONIA?



Laconia School District 3rd Grade Teachers toured the Laconia River Walk recently. Gail Bourn, Academic Coordinator of Teaching and Learning and Karen Switzer, Technology Integration Facilitator, worked together to develop and facilitate this training based on the Common Core State Standards, Social Studies Grade Level Expectations and National Education Technology Standards. A QR (Quick Response) Code walking tour was developed using video, voice and pictures. Through touring the Laconia River Walk in this way, the 3rd grade teachers learned how to use QR Codes, use technology to capture moments along the way and how to interact with our community. Through these interactions the teachers learned the historical, economic, environmental, social, and cultural aspects of the community. The teachers will now use these tools with their students to actively engage students in our community.




## LAPTOPS FOR LHS



Guruge, who has a variety of interests, is the author of 20 books. His subjects include astronomy, technology, papal history, and a couple of children's books.





With less than two weeks until the election, the time is now to get to know the candidates for Mayor of Laconia! On Sat., Oct. 26th, the WOW Trail will host a "Walk with the Candidates" event on the Trail. Beginning at 10 a.m. at the Lakeport trail entrance, candidates Ed Engler and Kaileif Mitchell will be walking the Trail and fielding questions from voters.

Presently 1.3 miles long, the WOW Trail spans from Elm St. in Lakeport to No. Main St. near Downtown Laconia. It is that time of year to not just change your clocks but to also take a minute and replace the battery in your smoke detectors. If you do not have smoke detectors in your home then go and buy at least one. At a minimum, there should be a smoke detector on the ceiling outside of the bedrooms.

It is estimated that 96% of all homes have a smoke detector. The big unknown is how many do not work.

The Laconia Fire Department urges everyone to change the batteries in their smoke detectors this weekend. If you don't change the battery at least test the smoke detector to make sure it is working. This simple test may mean the difference between life and death if you should have a fire in your home. Most people underestimate the threat of fire and they underestimate how much time they have to react to a fire. Smoke detectors improve your chance of surviving a fire by fifty percent. So replace your battery this weekend!

If your smoke detectors are more than ten years old it is highly recommended that you replace them. Recent studies by the National Fire Protection Association indicate that older smoke detectors are not working properly and they are giving a false sense of security. A smoke detector will not last forever.

Test your smoke alarms at least once a month using the test button, and make sure everyone in your home knows the sound.

- ▶ If an alarm "chirps" warning the battery is low, replace the battery right away.
- ▶ Change your batteries twice a year. When you change your clock, change your batteries.
- ▶ Keep smoke alarms dust free. Run the vacuum cleaner attachment over and around them.
