SEPTEMBER 23, 2013

Mayor Pro Tem Robert Hamel opened the discussion by asking Chief Adams to lead a Salute to the Flag. Mayor Pro Tem explained that because there is no quorum of the Council this would be an unofficial meeting.

Members of the Council in attendance were Councilors Doyle, Lahey and Bolduc. Also in attendance City Finance Director Woodaman. Recording of the non-meeting was conducted by Deputy City Clerk Lindsey Allen.

Mayor Pro Tem Hamel invited Police Chief Chris Adams to begin the POP Presentation. Chief Adams, Detective Chris Noyes, and Traci Fowler, the Partner in Prevention Regional Network Coordinator from the Lakes Region Partnership for Public Health, reviewed the presentation. It was explained that this POP Project will continue for the next few years because of the need. Detective Noyes reviewed the types of narcotics commonly found in the City and explained that the demand is high in a small sector of the population. Ms. Fowler reviewed the programs that are being worked on in the community with the different layers of involvement, including Stand Up Laconia. Mayor Pro Tem Hamel thanked the Laconia Police Department for what they are doing to keep the streets of the City safe.

Mayor Pro Tem Hamel commented that he had the opportunity to visit the building on Court Street that was destroyed by fire and the Fire Department did a remarkable job.

Finance Director Woodaman reviewed the Monthly Economic Development Report and Recycling Report. This was one of the best two-week cycles since the recycling program has begun with over 25% recycled.

All items requiring action will be addressed at the Council Meeting of October 15, 2013.
