Regular-

Entertainment & Outdoor Loudspeaker- 11 One Nine Artist Management is having a 2 day music festival featuring DJ's and some full bands to celebrate electronic music on August 10, 2012 from 3pm-2 am and on August 11, 2012 from 12pm- 2 am at 222 Rollercoaster Rd owned by the Foote Family Trust.

There was a lengthy conversation between the applicant and the board on the details and items that need to be worked out on the event as far as parking plans & emergency plans as well as the road conditions for emergency personnel getting in and out of the site. Chief Erickson asked about cancelation of the event in case of a thunder storm because August is well known here for severe thunderstorms. The applicant is seeking advice from the city on what to do in case of a weather emergency in the state. The applicant wants to create a plan that caters to the layout of the property and make sure that it is ok with the city. Shanna Saunders spoke and said that she was the one who recommended that the applicant comes in front of the board prior to going in front of the special events committee. Chief Erickson is concerned that the Motorcycle technical committee doesn't have the jurisdiction to be reviewing this plan because they are only used for motorcycle week; the board thinks that there should be an ad hoc special committee to be reviewing this and other special events. The license board thinks that the applicant needs some help creating plans of action in case of an emergency or making sure there are enough personnel hired for the event to make it safe. Chief Erickson offered to meet with her as well as Chief Adams and agreed that it was a good idea before she went in front of the technical review committee because the review committee looks at what it presented and approves or denies it. Lieutenant Canfield made a motion to table both applications pending the applicant going in front of the City Council to see about getting the time of the Outdoor Loudspeaker ordinance time extended seconded by Chief Erickson, Tabled.

The applicant is requesting to play until 2 am, the license board will be writing a memo to the City Council recommending that if they decide to extend the time period. The license board would like to see it be extended to no later than 12:00 am midnight

Event: Laconia Main Street Outdoor Marketplace is having an outdoor market on Thursdays from 3-7pm starting June 7 thru September 27 in the Main Street parking lot in between Main St & Pleasant St featuring local farmers, baked goods, crafts, flowers, meats, wines, etc. there will be entertainment & an outdoor loudspeaker and approximately 40 vendors each week. On March 26, 2012 The Laconia City Council waived the event fee.
