Councilor Doyle came to the meeting to speak with the board about our concerns with licensing multiple itinerant vendors for an event. Councilor Doyle said that everything has to be looked at on a case by case basis and the license board has to go by the ordinance and tell the organizers that licenses are required and if they aren't happy with the response they can get on a council agenda and present their case to the council and see if the fees would be waived.
