**Licensing Minutes:** The motion to accept the Licensing portion of the minutes for May 7, 2014 was made by J. Rogato and seconded by M. Canfield. The vote was 2-0 in favor of approval.

**SPECIAL EVENTS:**

A discussion was held on the hours of operation for the beer tents. No end time was set so this is up to the board's discretion. S. McCusker said that the Lobster Pound asked for midnight and wondered if Thursday's hours are different. K. Walsh said that the City Council said Friday vendors have to close by 11. M. Canfield said to make the end time as the same for regular Bike Week; he said he thinks if the City Council extended the days to include Thursday and Friday, we should make it a package deal, from noon until 1 am.

B. Niland, representing the Chop Shop for the Drive In, said if he is keeping his patrons later, he can regulate and hold them. If we make them close at 11, they can leave and go to another bar, which is open until 1, and drink more. He said he feels this helps Bike Week and not just the locals.

M. Canfield said he will require police details for Friday and Saturday.

**Licensing Motion:** M. Canfield moved to approve with the second by J. Rogato. Both voted in favor.  
**SERC Motion:** S. McCusker moved to approve with K. Walsh making the second. All voted in favor.

**2) Application # 2014-0087, 915 N Main St**  
**Renewal:** Marshmallow Man Triathlon

S. Saunders said there are porto potties and K. Dunleavy said the park house is open as well.

**Licensing Motion:** M. Canfield moved to approve with J. Rogato seconding. Both voted in favor.  
**SERC:** S. McCusker voted in favor and K. Walsh seconded. All voted in favor of approval.

**New:** Beer Tent 2014 Early BW

**Licensing Motion:** M. Canfield moved to approve with J. Rogato seconding. Both voted in favor.

**SERC Motion:** S. McCusker moved to approve with the second by K. Walsh. All voted in favor of approval.

**1) Application # 2014-0081, 691 Endicott St N, Tamarack**  
**Renewal:** Parking, Up to 50

**Motion:** K. Dunleavy moved to approve with the second by C. Roffo. All voted in favor.

**2) Application # 2014-0083, Boot Hill, 1065 Watson Rd**  
**Renewal:** Beer Tent W/Entertainment

C. Roffo asked about the exits from the structure to the tent as the plan shows a different sized tent than last year. They are also proposing a gazebo on the submitted plan.

The proposed gazebo and deck should be removed from the approval. Licensing approval for outdoor loudspeaker and entertainment was discussed. S. Saunders asked if they need a food license. C. Roffo said they must inspect and fax their finds to the liquor board after the inspection. C. Roffo suggested the standard COA. Porto potty contract is required.

**Motion:** St McCusker moved to approve with regular conditions, and the new conditions which exclude the proposed gazebo and proposed deck, obtaining the special liquor license, and obtaining the entertainment license and outdoor

loudspeaker and food service license. The porto potty contract must be submitted by June 1. K. Walsh seconded and all voted in favor of approval.

- 1) **Application # 2014-0089, 554 Endicott N, Looney Bin**  
**New:** Beer Tent 2014 Early BW

S. Saunders said this would have the same conditions as their regular approval. M. Canfield said they do not require a detail. K. Walsh said they are open from noon to 1 am.

S. Saunders said that the City Manager is recommending that the approvals that were already made on the beer tents stand.

**Motion:** S. McCusker moved to approve with the second by M. Canfield. All voted in favor of approval.
