MINUTES**

Present: Chairman James Rogato, Chief Ken Erickson, Captain Steve Clarke

New Business – Full Throttle Saloon/The Heat entertainment and loudspeaker license was taken out of order by Chief Erickson, seconded by Captain Clarke. Mark Cresswell, Jesse Dupree and Angie Carlson were at the meeting to discuss the proposed entertainment and loudspeaker license for the Full Throttle Saloon that will be at the Heat Restaurant. Chief Erickson asked about the items listed on the application. Mark Cresswell explained that the wall of death and moto x jumpers were not going to be at the event as listed on the application. Chief Erickson asked what they are proposing for dancers and Jesse Dupree said it was choreographed dancing performed regularly at night. Chief Erickson advised them of the city ordinance regarding nude dancing and sexually explicit material. Mark Cresswell said they were aware of the ordinance and their dancing is in good taste. The wrestling was discussed and they said it was going to be females wrestling in cake on Thursday and Friday and lasts about two hours. Captain Clarke wanted to know exactly where the location for the wrestling was and said it cannot be visible from the road for safety issues. Jesse Dupree said he would not put the wrestling in view of the road. Deputy Roffo was present and discussed the grade drop on the property and an overview of how occupancy is determined. Mark Cresswell said he understood the permit of assembly regulations. Chief Erickson reminded them that the MTRC does not meet again and the site plan needs to remain as submitted. Shanna Saunders was also present and requested an event schedule. Deputy Roffo wanted them to be aware that he needs to do an inspection before he issues a permit of assembly. Shanna Saunders wanted to make sure that restroom facilities were adequate enough on the property. Mark Cresswell said everything was all taken care of with adequate restrooms. Chief Erickson made a motion to approve the entertainment excluding the xmoto jumpers and wall of death, seconded by Captain Clarke, passed.
